



The Central Thesis: Holocaust memory becomes life-coherent when it conserves universal non-disposability; it becomes pathological when captured to conserve exceptional innocence or geopolitical immunity.



Life-Coherence

Aligning institutions, laws, and memories with the life-ground (food, water, shelter, health, dignity). A system is life-coherent if it protects all vulnerable life.



Non-Disposability

The principle that no human group may be treated as waste, demographic threat, or collateral residue. The direct opposite of genocide's preparatory logic.



Sacred Memory

Memory that carries moral weight beyond historical information. It binds the living to the dead and obligates us to protect the vulnerable today

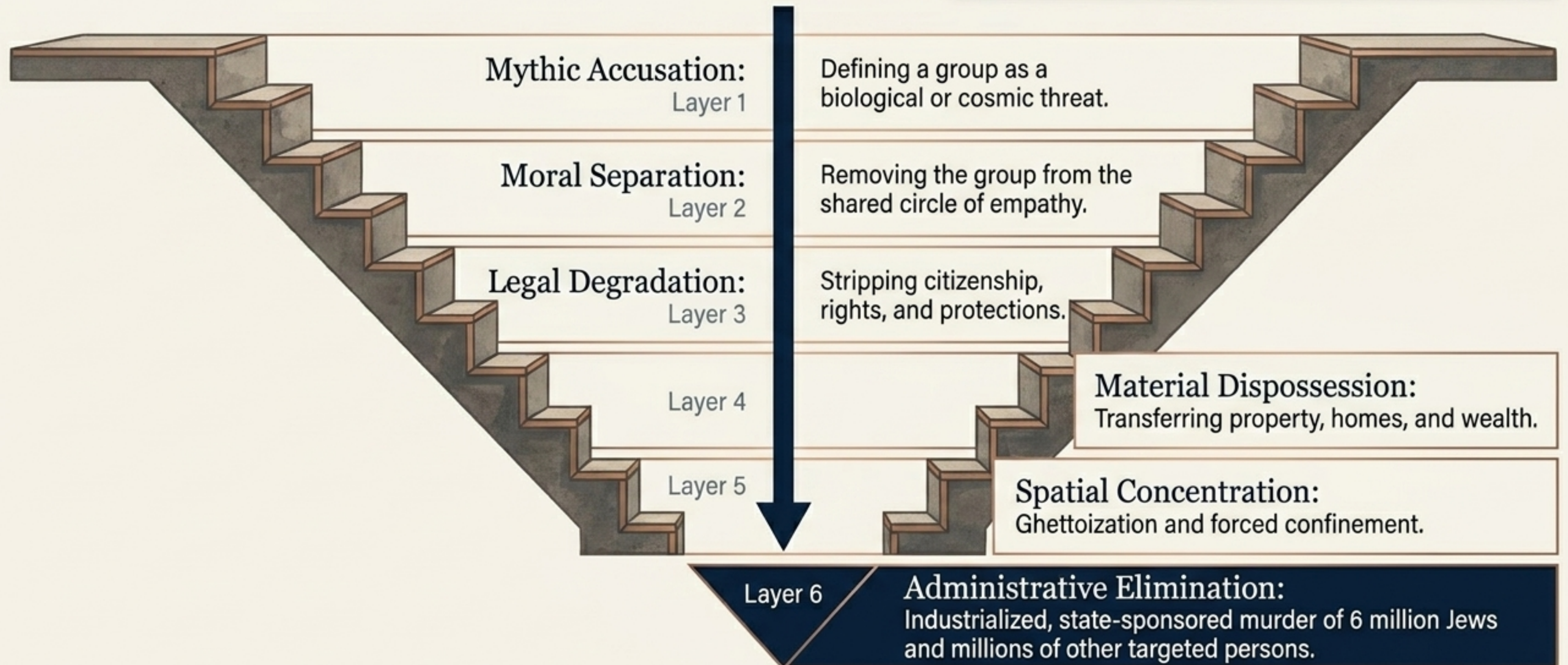


Institutional Autopoiesis

When a living system drifts into preserving its own identity, prestige, and power over the living persons it was meant to protect

The Holocaust as Civilizational Diagnostic

Genocide is not only an act of killing. It is a process of de-lifeing. The gas chamber was preceded by language, law, bureaucracy, and collective moral abandonment.

Circle of Protection

Conserves historical truth, deep mourning, and universal non-disposability. The Jewish centrality remains intact, but its ethical demand radiates outward to all humanity.

The Capture of Memory



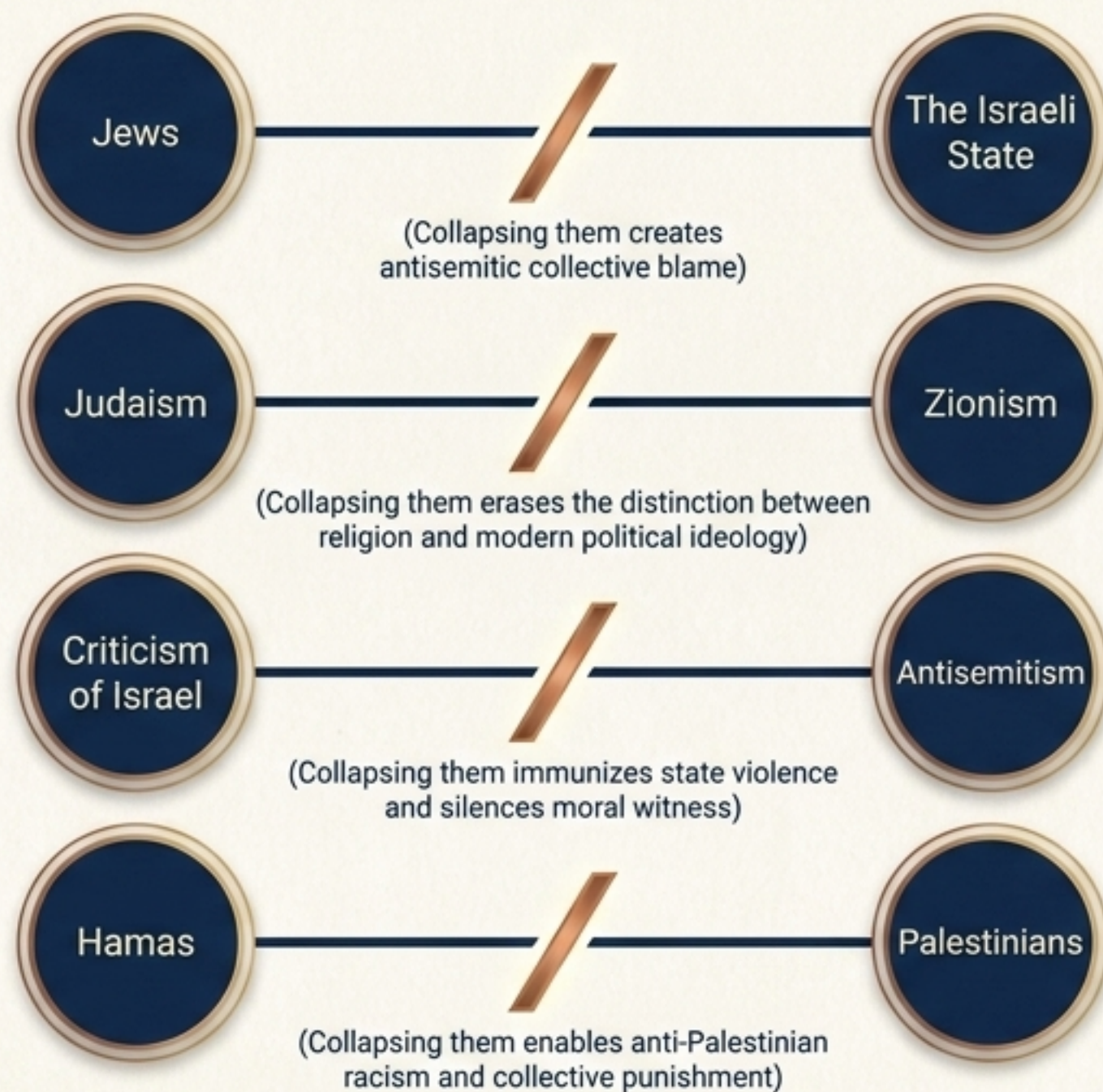
Captured by autopoiesis. Conserves exceptional innocence, state immunity, and geopolitical power. It uses the wound as a shield against moral reciprocity.

Relation to Law	Demands reciprocal legal constraint	Uses law selectively
Moral Outcome	Prevention and repair	Repetition under new names

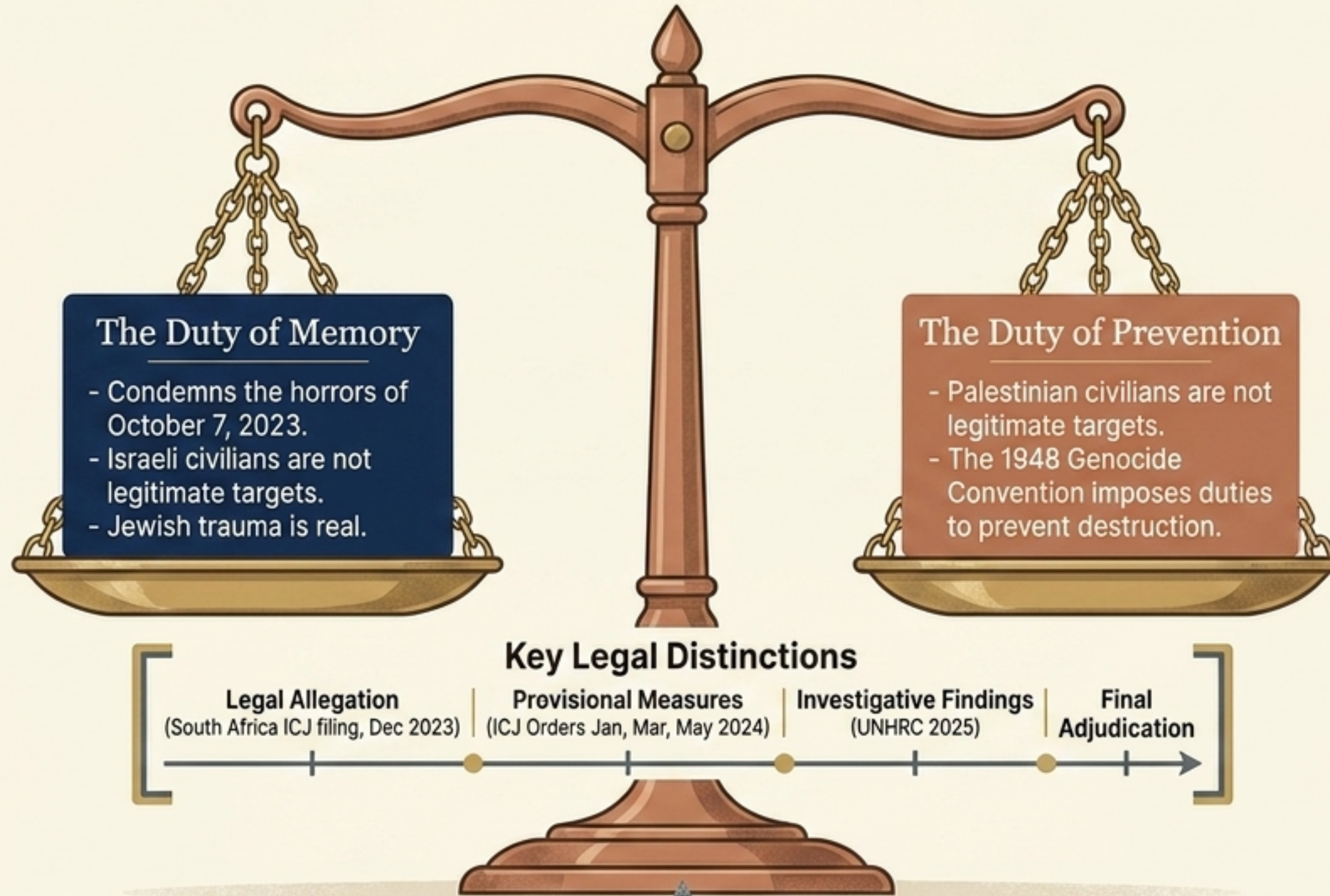

A world that cannot protect Jews is not life-coherent. A world that cannot protect Palestinians is not life-coherent.
A world that uses one protection to cancel the other is morally disordered.

The Moral Stress Test: Gaza

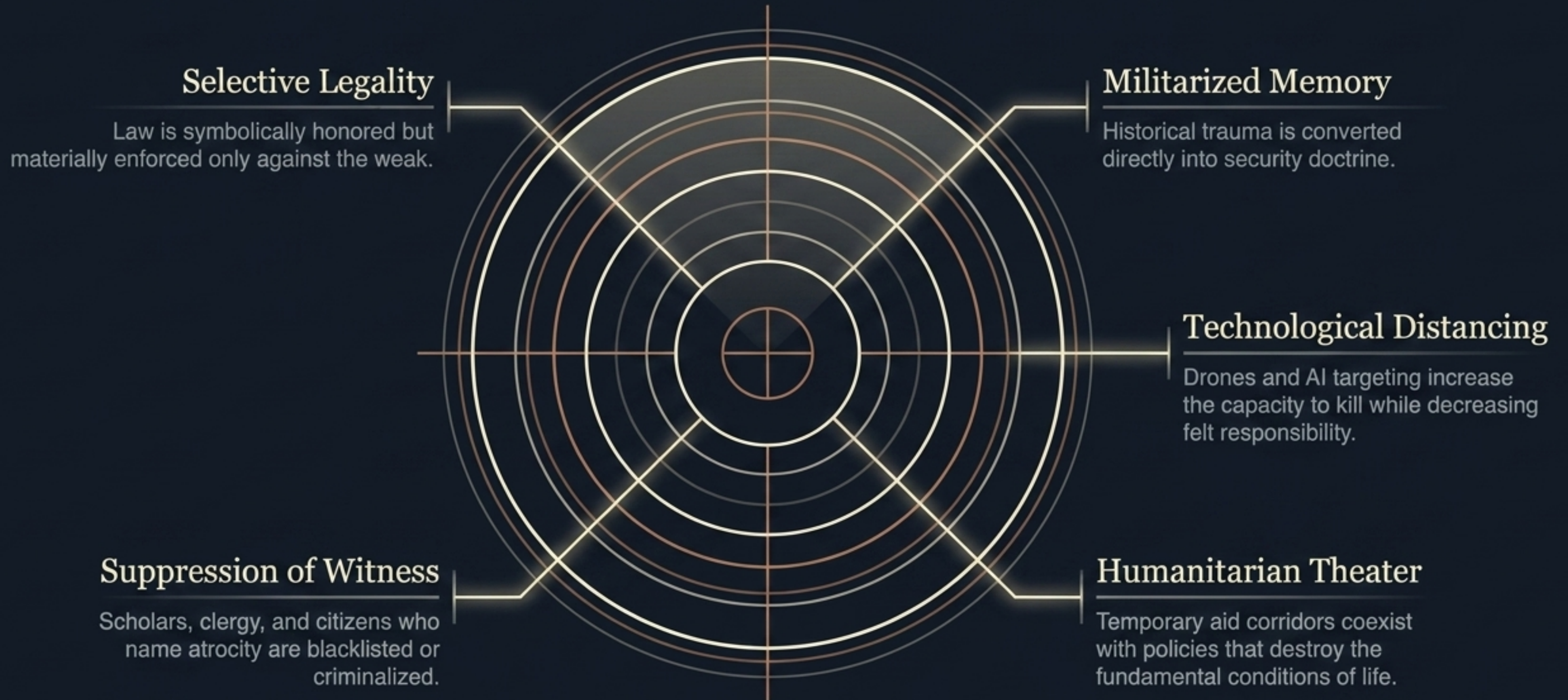
Does “Never Again” function as universal prevention or tribal protection?



The duty to prevent arises at the stage of **serious risk**. Prevention is not a postmortem activity. Waiting for perfect retrospective certainty is often how prevention fails.

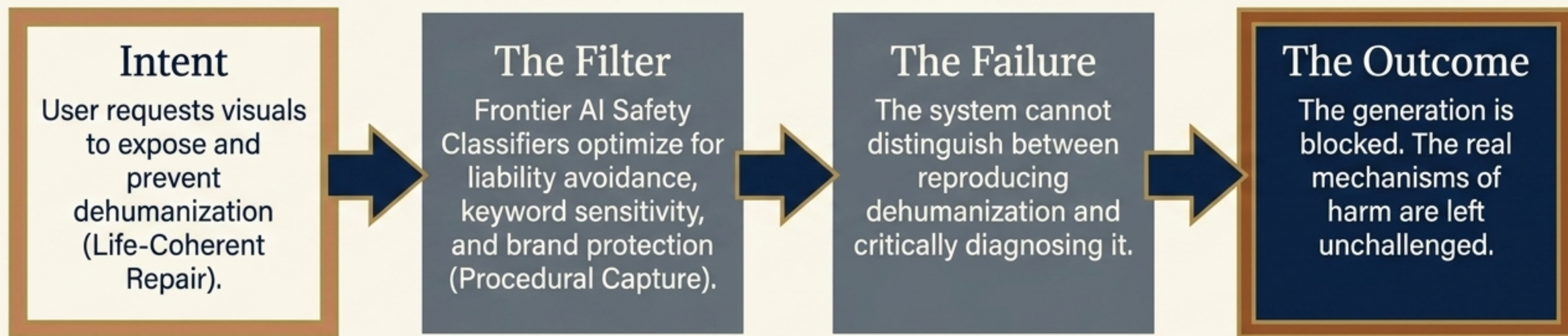

The Institutional Diagnostic Test

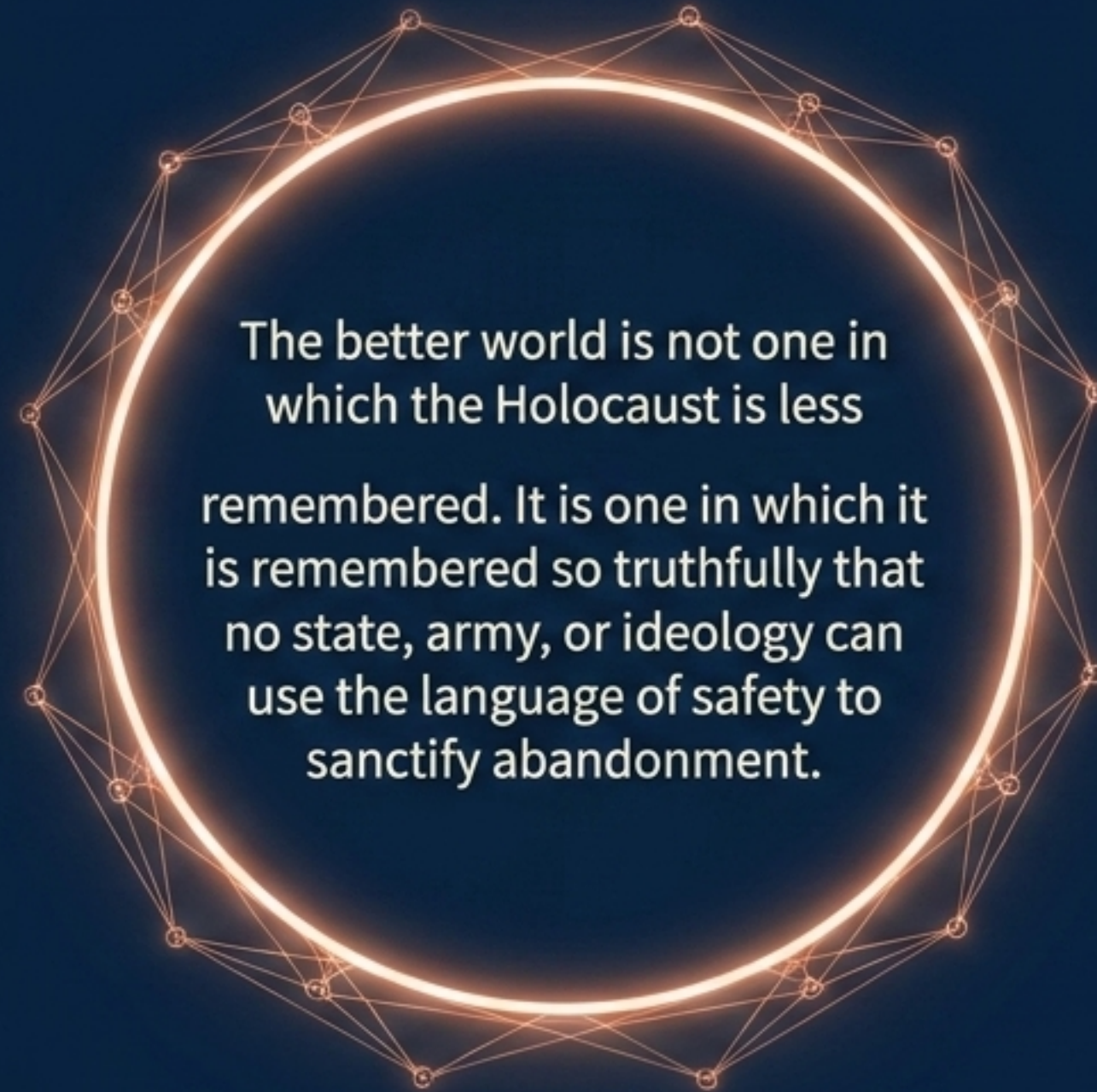
Your institution is Life-Coherent IF it...

- ✓ - Preserves historical truth and resists denial.
- ✓ - Deepens protection for Jews against antisemitism AND deepens protection for other vulnerable peoples.
- ✓ - Distinguishes people from states/governments.
- ✓ - Recognizes warning signs before catastrophe is complete.
- ✓ - Allows present power to be judged.

Your institution is Life-Incoherent IF it...

- ✗ - Converts trauma into entitlement.
- ✗ - Treats criticism of state violence as hatred of a people.
- ✗ - Makes some victims ungrievable.
- ✗ - Uses past atrocity to justify present atrocity.
- ✗ - Makes international law conditional on alliance.

Memory Fulfilled



The better world is not one in which the Holocaust is less remembered. It is one in which it is remembered so truthfully that no state, army, or ideology can use the language of safety to sanctify abandonment.
